

FairFX Anywhere Card v Caxton FX Global Card

We have drawn up a typical holiday spending example to show the cost of spending on a Caxton FX Global Card compared to a FairFX Anywhere Card.

We've taken into account a typical family trip with a £1500 spending budget. We have assumed that our average family will withdraw £500 worth of foreign currency from an ATM, and spend £1000 worth of currency in direct purchases.

Caxton FX Global Card

5 x £100 value ATM Withdrawal Costs	£7.50 (1.5% transaction fee)	£12.50 (2.5% FX fee)
£1000 value Direct Purchase Costs	£15 (1.5% transaction fee)	£25 (2.5% FX fee)
Total Cost to Consumer	£22.50	£37.50

Conclusion: The FairFX Anywhere Card is cheapest

Note: The only charges to consider when using both the FairFX Anywhere card and Caxton FX Global card abroad is the flat transaction fee of 1.5% or 2.5% (depending on the card).
